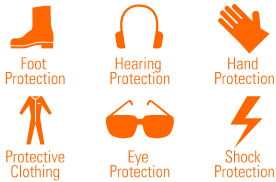


REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT



SAFETY FIRST

If you are collecting the equipment for someone else please make sure this sheet is given to the equipment user to read. This sheet should be given to the site supervisor if the equipment is being hired for commercial use so that the information is available to all users.

Before starting any job, be sure to spend a few minutes planning and understanding the hazards and risks of the job. Do this by:

- Thinking about and observing your surroundings
- Running through the steps of the job in your mind
- Identifying the hazards, how you can get hurt and how you'll prevent it
- Knowing what plant and equipment you need
- Only starting when you can do the job safely
- Ensuring you are trained or experienced for the task
- Communicating with everyone involved

Points to consider when planning a task. Can you:

- Come into contact with an energy source (e.g. heat, electricity, substance under pressure) or hazardous materials
- Be struck-by or against anything?
- Be caught-in, on or between anything?
- Slip, trip or fall on the same or too a lower level
- Strain or sprain a muscle?
- Cause damage to plant equipment or property?
- Spill or pollute something?

Instructions for Use



Pre-Start Checks and Safety

- The plug on the supply cord on the appliance must match the outlet
- Check the longopac dust collection bag is installed correctly
- Ensure lock down clamps are secure on the head of the machine
- Check hose for any leaks or damages and ensure size matches the tool being used
- Ensure wheels and brakes operate freely and lock securely
- It is recommended to use a P2 rated dust mask with this tool
- Hirepool do not allow this unit to be used with asbestos. If you suspect any asbestos has been present please alert the Hirepool team immediately.

When Operating

- When filter indicator is in the red please follow the instructions in the operator's manual – 5 purges of 5 seconds – should restore vacuum to green range
- If vacuum not restored - Filters are not user serviceable - please alert the Hirepool team immediately
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, flammable liquids. Do not use for collection of water/liquids
- The bag will generally fill only once the unit has been switched off and the debris falls from the cyclone chamber
- To dispose or renew the bag pull down enough bag and cable tie off. Install a second cable tie above and cut between to remove the bag

Starting Procedure

- For use with dry applications and indoor use only
- Connect the accessories and hose before connecting to power and starting, ensure has a tight seal
- Pull longopac bag to base of machine and cable tie the bottom.

Stopping and After Use

- Switch off the vacuum
- Unplug the vacuum supply cord and coil up
- To dispose of bag, pull down enough bag to cable tie off. Install second cable tie above the first and cut between ties.
- Remove hose and replace hose end cap to ensure no debris fall out.
- Dispose of bag appropriately
- Store the vacuum cleaner in a secure, dry place where it is inaccessible to unauthorised users
